**MOFFAT COUNTY AND CITY OF CRAIG EACH APPROVED
FOR AGNC TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANT**

**MONEY TO BE USED FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO CRAIG VISITOR CENTER
AND LOUDY SIMPSON REC AREA**

CRAIG – Mike Samson, Chairman of The Associated Governments of Northwest Colorado, Tom Mathers, AGNC Board member for Moffat County, and Ray Beck, AGNC Board Member from the City of Craig, are pleased to announce that through AGNC’s \$50,000 Mini-grant program awarded from Department Of Local Affairs, a \$3,750 grant, on behalf of the City of Craig, and a \$5,000 grant on behalf of Moffat County were approved by the AGNC committee.

Craig’s \$3,750 grant will be used for the purpose of constructing an internet based kiosk at the visitor’s center to highlight Craig’s tourist attractions. Craig City Officials say that the project will serve to make it easier for visitors to the city to know of all the great attractions Craig has to offer.

The \$5,000 Moffat County grant will be used by the County to construct a marquee for the Loudy Simpson Recreational Area.
